**Key vocabulary**

- **Equator:** an invisible line that runs around the centre of the earth
- **Physical features:** natural geography that would be here even if there were no people around e.g. seas, mountains and rivers.
- **Human features:** features built by people such as houses, roads and bridges.
- **Crops:** plants that are grown to be used or sold.
- **Population:** the number of people that are living in a place.
- **Wildlife:** the wild animals and plants in an area.
