Y6 will focus on:

- Ratio, Algebra, Area, Perimeter and Volume

Y5 will focus on:

- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Decimals and Percentages

Y4 will focus on:

- Measurement: Mass & Capacity; Time,
- Number: Fractions & Decimals

Class Three 'Oh I Do Like To Be Beside The Seaside' Summer 1 2023

History – Is the monarchy still as important and powerful in today's society?.

Throughout this unit the children will: Use different types of evidence to interpret the character of Henry VIII. Understand why Henry VIII had many wives.

Extract evidence from primary sources about the Royal Progresses of Elizabeth and understand what happened in the Victorian era.

Learn about the royal coronation. Consider the monarchy's role in modern life.

PE

On Thursdays, children will be developing their Dodgeball skills working through a unit of work to develop Teamwork, throwing and catching, attacking and defending skills.

On Fridays, children will work on their Striking and Fielding skills with WLSP.

Music – Sounds of the Seaside: Graphic Notation

Within this theme, children will develop singing, listening, music appreciation and composing skills through the medium of seaside inspired music. They will use song to further develop singing technique; classical and contemporary music to debate old and new styles of music; and compose music to seaside poetry using graphic notation of their own.

Science – Electricity

The children will be making an application for a job as the one the team of electricians responsible for the maintenance of the Blackpool Illuminations. However they must undergo comprehensive assessment and training for it. Throughout the learning in this theme, they will be set a series of challenges to test their problem solving and collaboration skills using electrical circuits. Each group of applicants must present the results of respective challenges to the panel for the Illuminations, explaining what they found out and presenting circuit diagrams of their solutions. The children will collate their presentations in a 'Blackpool Illuminations' portfolio which will be judged by a specially selected panel.

Computing - Spreadsheets

Using 2Calculate children will:

Use a spreadsheet to investigate the probability of rolling a dice.

Create a computational model able to calculate discounts.

Use a spreadsheet to plan pocket money spending and saving.

Plan a school event.

Art – 3D Sculptures - Crowns.

Linked to the Coronation of Charles III, children will research different crown designs.

They will research different crowns throughout history, creating detailed and labelled sketches.

They will use paper to practice creating different shapes and styles of crown.

They will then create a wire frame based on our sketches and designs.

Then the children look to develop these further using clay building and sculpting techniques in order to sculpt a clay crown.

Finally using a range of techniques, the children will etch patterns and adorn their crowns with a range of jewels.
