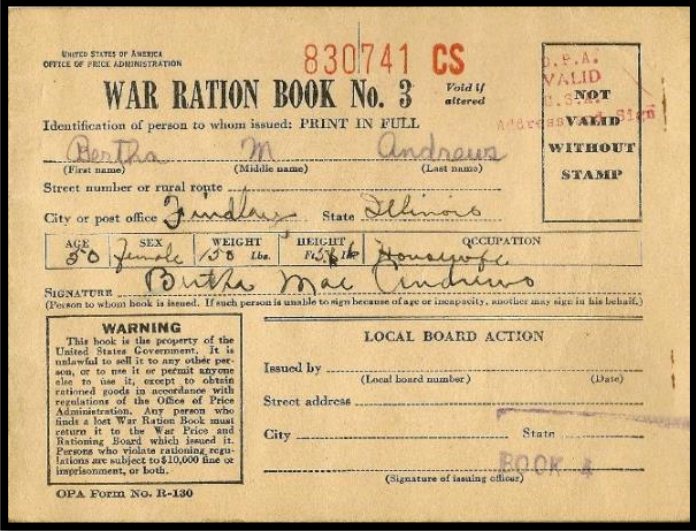

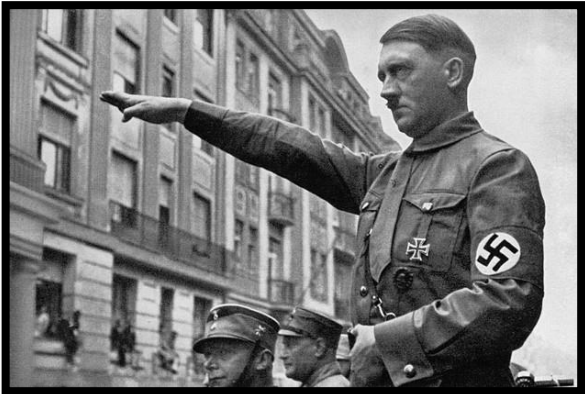


Propaganda Posters

Key Vocabulary	
Allies	To join or unite for a particular purpose. The allies consisted of British, USA, Soviet Union (Russia) and France, among other allied nations
Axis alliance	Germany, Italy and Japan
Nazi Party	Officially the National Socialist German Workers' Party was a far-right political party in Germany active between 1920 and 1945
Annex	A building joined to or associated with a main building, providing additional space or accommodation.
Propaganda	Information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political cause or point of view.
Active service	Someone who takes part in a war as a member of the armed forces
Anderson shelters	A small prefabricated air-raid shelter of a type built in the UK during the Second World War
Land girls	A woman farmworker doing work to replace a man absent in military service
