

## Maths

- Number, with a particular emphasis on place value, addition and subtraction. Y2 will also continue to develop their knowledge of multiplication and division.
- All mathematical concepts will be taught with the use of concrete resources and pictorial methods. Ongoing 'problem solving' activities are embedded into daily lessons.
- Times tables are of vital importance in all aspects of maths work in school. Please encourage your child to access games on the TT Rockstars website to help their rapid recall of multiplication and division facts related to times tables.

## Science

- Observe and describe changes across the four seasons.
- Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length and temperature varies.

## Computing

- Understand how online actions can affect others.
- Know the risks of sharing images without permission.
- Understand the types of images you should and should not post online.
- Understand what is meant by 'technology' and consider how it is used in and out of school.

## RE

- To identify things that make our world special.

## English

- Folk Tales
- Recount: Biography
  - Secure the use of full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and question marks.
  - Use sentences with different forms: statement, question, command and exclamation.
  - Say, write and punctuate simple and compound sentences using the connectives *and*, *but* and *or*.
  - Use commas to separate items in a list.
  - Say, hold in memory and write simple sentences.
  - Separate words with spaces.
  - Use punctuation to demarcate simple sentences.
  - Use a capital letter for the personal pronoun I.
- In addition to the daily English lesson, all children will have ongoing handwriting and phonics sessions.
- Years 2 & 3 will also have a daily Reading session focusing on vocabulary and comprehension skills.
