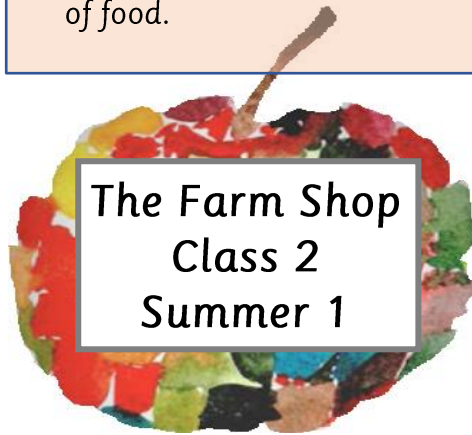
## RE

## Science

- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy and how changing these affects the plant.

## History

### (What the Romans Did for Us)

- Making *some* links between and across periods
- Identifying where some periods studied fit into a chronological framework by noting connections, trends and contrasts over time.
- Understanding *some* of the ways in which people's lives have shaped this nation.
- Describing how Britain has influenced and been influenced by the wider world.
- Understanding some significant aspects of history
- Use sources as a basis for research from which they will begin to use information as evidence to test simple hypotheses.
- Identify some of the different ways in which the past can be represented, and that different versions of the past such as an event *may* exist (*artist's pictures, museum displays, written sources*).

## Computing

- To use 2 Calculate image, lock, move cell, speak and count tools to make a counting machine.
- To learn how to copy and paste in 2Calculate.
- To use the totalling tools.
- To use a spreadsheet for money calculations.
- To use the 2Calculate equals tool to check calculations.
- To use 2Calculate to collect data and produce a graph.

## English

- Stories with familiar settings
- Persuasion
- Riddles
- Y2 -Use apostrophes for contracted form.
- Y2 -Use apostrophes for possession.
- Y3 -Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech.
- Y1-Extend range of joining word to link words and clauses using 'but' and 'or'
- In addition to the daily English lesson, Year 1 have daily phonics sessions.
- Years 2 & 3 follow a focused spelling programme which is based on a two weekly cycle.
- Years 2 & 3 will also have a daily Reading session focusing on vocabulary and comprehension skills.
- A short daily handwriting session.

## Music
