Baby Discover 6+ mths

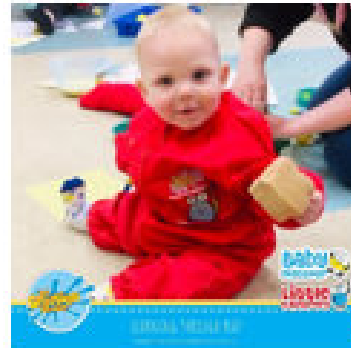

Because a huge dinosaur skeleton was discovered in a man's back garden...

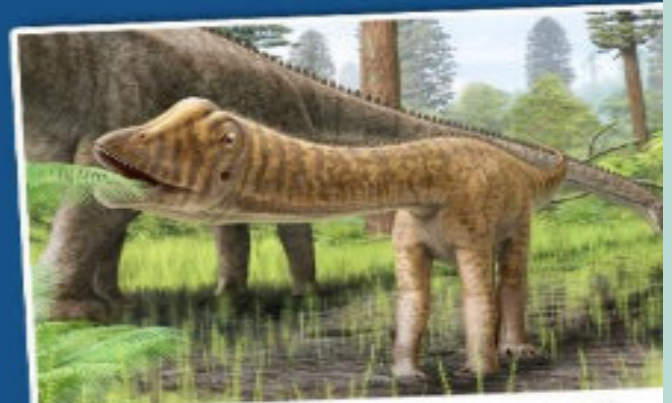


...It is the biggest fossil ever found in Europe!
