- Times tables are of vital importance in all aspects of maths work in school. Please encourage your child to access games on the TT Rockstars (Y2+) and 'numbots' website to help their rapid recall of multiplication and division facts related to times tables.
- In addition to the daily maths lesson, all children in Years 1 & 2 access a 15 minute 'Mastering Number' session which focuses on developing 'Number sense' and 'fluency'.

History

- The Great Fire of London
- Recognise the distinction between past and present.
- Understand key features of events during The Great Fire of London and identify that changes that happened affect today.



Science

- Recognise that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and there are ways to protect our eyes.
- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.
- Find patterns in the way that the size of shadows can change.

- Listen to and appraise London's Burning.
- Consider how 'fire' has inspired composers for hundreds of years.

Computing

- Understand what instructions are.
- Predict what will happen when instructions are followed.
- Understand that computer programs work by following instructions called code.
- Use code to make a computer program.
- Understand what objects and actions are.
- Understand what an event is.
- Use an event to control an object.
- Begin to understand how code executes when a program is run.
- Understand what backgrounds are.
- Understand how to use the scale property.
- Plan and make a computer program.

English

- Y1 & Y2 – Stories with repetitive patterns and a range of non-fiction texts.
- Y3 – Fables and persuasive letters.
- Y1 – Identify and use question marks and exclamation marks; use a capital letter for the personal pronoun I.
- Y2 – Say, write and punctuate simple and compound sentences using the connectives *and*, *but* and *or*; use sentences with different forms: statement, question, command and exclamation.
- Y3 – Select, generate and effectively use adverbs; select, generate and use adverbs for time; identify clauses in sentences.
- In addition to the daily English lesson, Year 1 and 2 have daily phonics sessions.
- Year 3 follows a focused spelling programme which is based on a two weekly cycle.
- Years 2 & 3 will also have a daily Reading session focusing on vocabulary and comprehension skills.
- A short daily handwriting session.
